I'm delighted to welcome you to our third Arts Festival, sponsored by Bilborough councillors.

The idea for a whole week's festival came three years ago when we organised an exhibition of artwork from Bilborough schools and local artists in Bilborough Library. The success of this led us to get a group of residents together to organise a week of events in July 2017 and another in July 2018. We wanted to show that 'arts' included such a wide range of activities that there would be something for everyone.

So far we've featured: impressive exhibitions in Bilborough library showing paintings, drawings, photographs and sculptures by local artists; in other venues we've had music – rock and jazz, drumming, dancing, clowning, creative workshops for toddlers, families and older people, films, a craft fair, a heritage walk, Tai Chi, knitting and crochet, storytelling, a word fest and much more. We've involved schools, churches, independent living schemes and lots of local residents.

As you'll see from the programme there are events for all ages from toddlers to our older residents. We're delighted that most of our schools are taking part again this year as well as local care homes and independent living schemes. One of our aims is to bring younger and older people together, which benefits both groups.
